

CBR/EATON PLACE IMPROVEMENTS



We have mobilized input from the community on the City's proposed improvements to the Chain Bridge Road / Eaton Place intersection, including a community meeting held in July and through surveys administered on our Facebook page. The City has made changes to the plan in response to our concerns, but there are still widespread concerns within the community about the latest plan. We recently succeeded in delaying a vote by City Council on this plan in order for us to provide additional input. We are organizing a meeting with City officials in the coming weeks.
