#### ADOPTING COBBDALE PARK



The Cobbdale Civic Association has officially adopted Cobbdale Park. The City will be changing the Adopt-A-Spot sign in the coming weeks.

Ray Girouard has meticulously cared for our beautiful park for many years. As an association we would like to actively engage the entire neighborhood to care for the park. We will be planning a park cleanup four times a year. The first official cleanup following our park adoption was on July 29th. A HUGE thank you to the neighbors who came out and helped rake, clean up around the playground equipment, and replenish the rocks around the stream. Our next cleanup is **Saturday November 4th @ 9:00am.** Stormwater Utility credits will be available for participants at each park cleanup.





#### INVASIVE SPECIES EVENT & PARK CLEANUP





In conjunction with our next park cleanup on **November 4th**, we will be hosting Anna Safford, Urban Forester for the City of Fairfax, along with Katy Johnson, Certified Master Naturalist, and Cobbdale resident Christina Wren, who are volunteers with "Plant NOVA Natives." This is an opportunity for our community to learn more about invasive species and discuss the responsibility of homeowners to manage and mitigate these plants. Additionally we will learn about native species and their importance when planning plantings in our yards. A few lucky neighbors will receive native seedlings.

#### HOLIDAY DECORATING CONTESTS







#### PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

#### A few reminders about pedestrian safety:



When you're out walking, please remember to walk against traffic, on the left side of the road. This provides pedestrians the ability to see oncoming traffic and not be surprised by a vehicle at their back (especially quiet hybrid and electric vehicles).



When you're on your bike, please ride with traffic, on the right side of the road. Unless you're one of Cobbdale's junior cyclists biking with an adult pedestrian!



For evening walks, please consider wearing reflective clothing and carrying a strong flashlight.



Back to school brings school buses and some of our youngest pedestrians. Please be mindful of bus stops, respect school bus lights, and watch for walkers.

#### TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS



The Chain Bridge Road/Eaton Place Intersection project was approved by City Council. The new light at Chain Bridge Road and Willow Crescent Drive has been installed, but is not yet operating. Once that light is in use we will be following up with the city on updated traffic data for the CBR/Eaton intersection.
